Regular Village Council Meeting
 February 8, 2010

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the January, 2010 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Ms. Watson seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.
