ORDINANCE INCREASING THE COMPENSATION
TO BE PAID TO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF
PUBLIC AFFAIRS OF THE VILLAGE OF
HAMERSVILLE FROM TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00)
TO TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00) PER MEETING
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1986, REPEALING
FORMER COMPENSATION ORDINANCE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

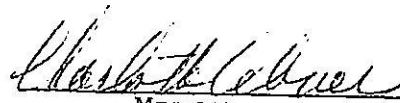
BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of
Hamersville, more than three-fourths (3/4ths) of its members
concurring hereto:

SECTION 1. That the compensation to be paid to members of
the Board of Public Affairs of the Village of Hamersville be
set at Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per meeting, effective January 1,
1986.

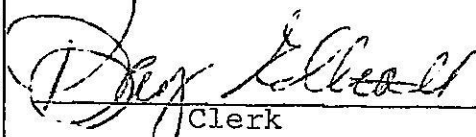
SECTION 2. That the Ordinance establishing the compensation
at the rate of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per meeting to the members of
the Board of Public Affairs of the Village of Hamersville be
and hereby is repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency ordinance necessary for the public safety and welfare
of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County,
Ohio, for the reason that it is necessary to pay sufficient
compensation to the members of the Board of Public Affairs in
recognizing the increased activity and obligations of the Board,
and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately
upon its passage.
