

COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1976-2

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING UNLAWFUL
ASSEMBLAGES AND UNLAWFUL LOITERING
IN THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE,
Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all members
thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION I. That it is hereby declared unlawful for two
or more people to assemble or loiter on private property used
for business purposes after closing hours of the respective
business or businesses for which said private property is used
between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. on the following
day, without the prior written consent of the owner, lessee,
tenant, or person having the right to the possession of said
real estate.

SECTION II. It is hereby declared unlawful for two or
more people to assemble or loiter on public property in the
Village of Hamersville, Ohio, between the hours of 11:00 P.M.
and 7:00 A.M. on the following day, without first obtaining
a written permit from the Mayor for said assemblage.

SECTION III. That any violation of this Ordinance is hereby
declared to be a minor misdemeanor and shall be punishable on
the first offense of a fine up to \$50.00 and costs of prosecution,
and for a second and continuing offense, a fine of up to \$100.00
plus costs of prosecution, and each specific violation of this
ordinance shall be considered a separate offense.
