VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 1990-16

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE
FIVE MOST PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN
THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamersville is a municipal corporation in which no newspaper is published, as defined by Section 7.12 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 731.25 of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary to publish ordinances in not less than five of the most public places within the municipal corporation, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, at least a majority of its member concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following places are hereby designated as the five most public places within the Village of Hamersville:

Post Office, Village Office,
Candler Shop, Post Office, Hensons
Feed Mill

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of the Village of Hamersville is hereby directed to publish each ordinance at least 15 days prior to its effective date, subject to the provisions of Section 731.30 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it is necessary to immediately establish a procedure for publication of ordinances and resolutions to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hamersville.
