electric drop for the village Christmas tree.

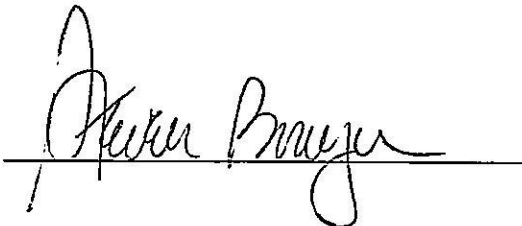
A motion was heard to hire Marty Rolph as needed for snow
