of June 1, 1989 .

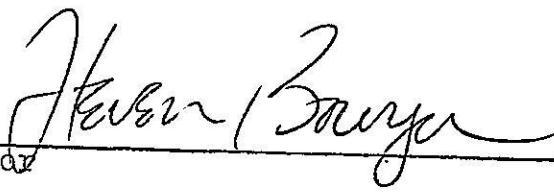
1990 Proposed Budget was tabled .
