

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE OHIO FOR SIDEWALK AND STORM DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS ALONG STATE ROUTE 125 AND EAST MAIN STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamersville has identified a need for pedestrian infrastructure and stormwater drainage improvements along State Route 125 and East Main Street; and

WHEREAS, existing sidewalks within the project corridor are deteriorated, uneven, and in some cases impassable, creating safety concerns for pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, existing storm drainage infrastructure within the corridor is deteriorated or inadequate, contributing to standing water, erosion, and continued infrastructure failure; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to rehabilitate sidewalks, improve ADA accessibility, and address stormwater drainage deficiencies to improve public safety and infrastructure reliability; and

WHEREAS, funding assistance is available through the Ohio Public Works Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for funding assistance for sidewalk and storm drainage improvements along State Route 125 extending to East Main Street.

SECTION 2. The Village commits to providing any required local match and to cooperating with all program requirements associated with the project.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council in compliance with applicable law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village, specifically to meet funding application deadlines; therefore, it shall take effect immediately upon passage.
