

ORDINANCE NO. 285

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ACCELERATION
OF VEHICLES AND UNREASONABLE LOUD NOISES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Incorporated Village
of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all
members elected thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to "race" or accelerate
any motor of a vehicle while the motor vehicle
is not in gear or while it is in motion so as to
cause unreasonable loud noises, and it shall be
unlawful to excessively "race" or accelerate
the motor of any vehicle while moving in first
or in second gear so as to cause unreasonable
loud noise.

SECTION 2. Anyone violating this ordinance shall be fined
not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more
than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first
offense; and anyone guilty of a second offense
within a one year period from the first
offense shall be fined not less than Twcnty-Five
Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred
Dollars (\$100.00).

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
ordinance necessary for the public peace and safety of the
inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, and shall be in
effect immediately upon its passage.
