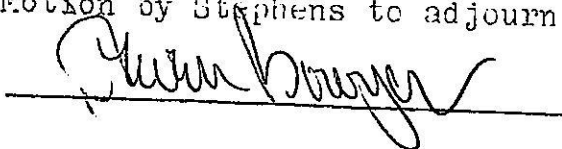

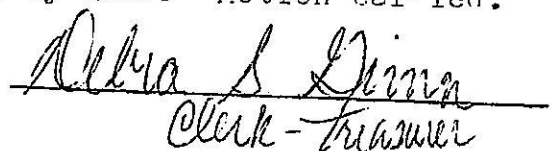
Moore asked to cover his ditchline and use the motion as of Sept. 7, 1987 to have the village pay up to 150.00 for the dirt.
