| Meter Reader .....      | \$7.75 per hour  |

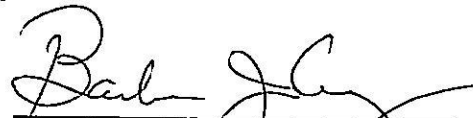
The increases will be effective beginning February 1, 1994.
