REGULAR MEETING JUNE 17, 1996 7:00 P.M.

President Hanes called the meeting to order at 7:06 P.M.

Mr. Martin motioned to accept the minutes of the May 1995 meeting as presented. Mr. Hanes seconded the motion. All voted YEA. **Motion Carried.**

Mr. Martin motioned to pay the bills as presented on the voucher. All Voted YEA. **MOTION CARRIED.**

The clerk told the Board about the copy of the letter she had received from the village solicitor on the damage caused by the mobile home transporter.

Mr. Saylor reported that the water is holding up real well however he had to turn the pumps up due to people filling pools and etc.

Mr. Saylor also reported that Mr. Van Harlingen will have someone contact the village in regards to some repair work that needs to be done at the pump house.

The estimates for the counter for the utility collectors office was discussed and Mr. Hanes motioned to have Kevin Ogle build and

install the counter complete for the sum of seven hundred and forty three dollars (\$743.00) This was seconded by Mr. Martin. All voted

YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

The Board discussed the need for another member for the Board of Public Affairs. If Any one knows of any resident who would be interested they should have them at the next village council meeting.

The Board discussed the need for a drop box for the payment of utility bills. The consensus was to check around and see what the best options would be.

Mr. Dunn reported that he had no word on the electric line from the C. G. & E Co.

Mr. Dunn also reported that he had not been contacted by Western Brown School in regards to the modular units they are planning to install.

Mr. Martin suggested that perhaps the village should look at increasing the charges for water taps since all the other water companies are increasing their rates. The rates from the other towns will be checked and this will be discussed further at the next meeting.

The water truck used by Mr. Saylor was discussed it is a 1984 model purchased in 1989 for four thousand dollars (\$4000.00) it had 72,000 miles when we purchased it. the mileage is now over 100,000 miles.

Mr. Hanes reported that Mike Jones Motors had some 1992 model trucks that he was selling for six thousand dollars (\$6,000.00). Mr.

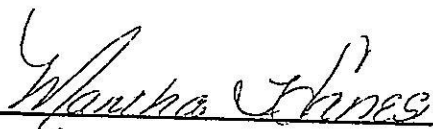
Martin said that he did not want any thing to do with Jones. Mr. Hanes and Mr. Saylor to look at Jones trucks and see what they are.
