Regular Village Council Meeting
February 13, 2006

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Kevin Ogle, Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Larry Talbott, Betty Kirkpatrick, Jack Shouse and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Mike Clark, Gary Donner, Carolyn Donner, Donna Tolliver, Crystal Robke, Chief Canter, Edna Pride, Kevin Smith, Cecelia Potts and Jeff Thompson.

Mayor Staggs called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the last meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status, Appropriation Status Reports and the January, 2006 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. The Council read and approved all other reports and the Bank Reconciliation.

The Clerk Treasurer presented all bills to the Council as follows:

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Staggs recognized Mike Clark, who is Brown County Health Department's Emergency Response Coordinator. He came to enlist volunteers for the Brown County Medical Reserve.

Mayor Staggs recognized Edna Pride, who wants to replace a trailer in her Mobile Home Park. Mr. Staggs made a motion to allow her a variance on square footage, and Mr. Talbott seconded it. Roll call vote resulted as follows: Mr. Ogle-Yes, Mr. Staggs-No, Mr. Tolliver-No, Mr. Talbott-No, Ms. Kirkpatrick-No, Mr. Shouse-Yes. Ms. Pride also wants to annex a couple of acres into town. Ms. Potts explained the process.

The Hamersville Fall Festival Committee sent the Village a check for \$875.16, with a note asking that it be used for flags or Christmas Decorations. The Council agreed to put it in the General Fund to purchase flags.

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Mr. Talbott made a motion to accept the new contract from the Brown County Sheriff, raising the daily rate to \$25.00 per day. Mr. Shouse seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an Ordinance three times. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Mr. Ogle made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2006-04, the Ohio Basic Code 2006. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Bruce Brandstetter has told Mayor Staggs that there is no point in asking for a sidewalk grant. He suggested contacting Jim Beasley. Mr. Staggs will look into the situation more closely.

Mayor Staggs recognized Jeff Thompson, who asked for a variance for a mobile home on his property on Fite Avenue. Mr. Staggs made a motion to allow for a variance for a 1280 sq. ft. mobile home. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and a roll call vote resulted as follows: Mr. Ogle-Yes, Mr. Staggs-No, Mr. Tolliver-No, Mr. Talbott-No, Ms. Kirkpatrick-No, Mr. Shouse-Yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
