

Hamersville Board of Public Affairs
Regular Meeting
July 23, 1990 - 7:00 P.M.

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Present were: James Hanselman, Charles Tucker, Eric Mullis

and a visitor Patti Schwartz

President Hanselman called the meeting to order and asked Clerk-Treasurer to read the minutes of the previous meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

President Hanselman asked Lynn Dunn if he had met with Mrs. Neal about the lighting situation. He had and said Mrs. Neal indicated they would purchase their own lights and have them installed.

President Hanselman asked Mrs. Schwartz if she would like to address the Board. Mrs. Schwartz explained she has been paying an extra 9.60 each month for the past year for a mobile home on her property that has been vacant for over 1 year. She would like for us to stop billing her for this extra 9.60 and perhaps a refund. President Hanselman explained that the property is not to have to residents on 1 tap, but since she purchased the property that way we would not penalize her for this type of hook-up. Board will check with Village Solicitor to see how to resolve this situation. Mrs. Schwartz thanked the Board for their time and left the meeting.

Clerk-Treasurer Craig informed Board she had a phone conversation with a Mr. Steve Huff of the Ohio Dept. of Transportation in regard to invoices sent for water break on SE 125. Mr. Huff said the Dept. of Transportation is willing to pay the \$250.00 for repair costs but will only pay \$250.00 of the \$984.90 for water loss. Mr. Huff said we could not prove the total gallons lost, and they would pay only a portion.. Board will seek Solicitor Leicht's opinion on this.

Board discussed the vacancy created by Mrs. Blanton's resignation. Even though Mrs. Blanton was a sub-on-call only and vacked up when collector was on vacation, it is a position that should be filled.

Mayor Bowyer informed Board that Council will ask for an extension of current garbage contract with Rumpke rather than seek bids at this time.

Mayor Bowyer said he had been approached about having a street light installed at corner of Wayne and Travis. Lynn will check into this and report back at tnext meeting.

The next regular meeting will be August 27th.

There being no further business, Tucker moved, Mullis seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting.

President Hanselman adjourned the meeting.
