President Hanselman called the meeting to order and asked for the reading of the minutes of the January meeting. Clerk-Treasurer read the minutes. The minutes were approved as read.

Bills were presented for payment. At this point, President Hanselman asked Clerk-Treasurer Craig to read letter received from Mayor Steve Bowyer. Clerk-Treasurer Craig read the letter in which Mayor Bowyer stated that in the future he would not be signing any more checks in which Village supplies were not delivered on Village property. Discussion followed. The reason the electrical supplies are delivered to the Electrician's home is due to fact Village can not afford to hire someone to be available full time to accept deliveries. A discussion followed. again. President Hanselman asked Councilman Staggs to get an opinion from Solicitor Leicht on this dilemma and to report back at our next regular meeting. In the meantime, Mr. Dunn will not order any more electrical supplies until we get this resolved.

Bills were approved for payment as presented.

President Hanselman asked Councilman Staggs if he would also ask Solicitor Leight as to why we have to continue to pay VanHarlingen monthly for water testing since our water is purchased from another entity, has already been treated and tested two times.

Lynn said brakes on electric department truck needed repair, and that he had an estimate of \$1200.00. Board asked Lynn to see if he could get another estimate. Lynn informed Board that he had to get hitch repaired on truck so he could pull chipper.

President Hanselman informed Board that water line on Liming Van Thompson Road need attention and should be taken care of soon.

President Hanselman informed employees that a 5% salary increase has been proposed to Council.

There being no further business, Mullis moved, Tucker seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting.

President Hanselman adjourned the meeting.
