Regular Village Council Meeting
May 9, 2011

Skip will take care of the trash on Wooster, being thrown out because of the new gas station.

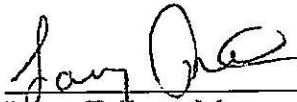
Chief Canter has given out three warnings for vehicles without plates, and three letters about barking dogs.

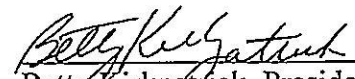
Council discussed moving Mayor's Court.

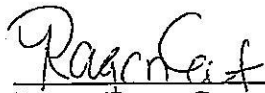

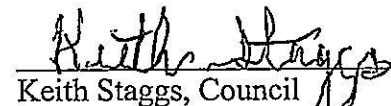
Mr. K Staggs told Wayne Johnson that the Council needs the actual house plans before he starts building the house beside his Church.

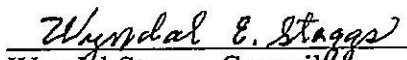
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Ernst seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

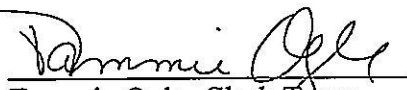
