Regular Village Council Meeting
November 13, 2006

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Larry Talbott, Betty Kirkpatrick, Jack Shouse and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Scott McKinney, Roy Day, Michele Cahall, Danny Rose, Chief Canter, Roger Adkins, Cecelia Potts, Gary Bronner and Mike Rector of Time Warner Cable.

Mayor Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to appoint Roy Day to Council to replace Kevin Ogle. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Mayor Staggs then swore Mr. Day in.

We received one bid for the snow removal. It was from Jared Cornett, at \$75.00 per hour. Mr. Talbott made a motion to accept the bid, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, with all members voting yes, except Ms. Kirkpatrick, who voted no.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the October, 2006 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Talbott seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Staggs recognized Roger Adkins, who came to discuss the Clermont County Commercial building codes. He encouraged Council to enter into a contract with them. The Council will consider it, and look into the residential contract with Brown County.

Mayor Staggs recognized Gary Bronner, who brought a re-plat for signatures. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the survey, and Mr. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Staggs recognized Mike Rector, who represents Time Warner Cable. He just came to introduce himself.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to accept the Prisoner Housing Contract with Brown County for \$25.00 per day, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. Mr. Talbott made a motion to accept the Prisoner Housing Contract with Highland County for \$55.00 per day, and Mr. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Chief Canter thanked the Fire Department and Life Squad for their help on Beggars Night. The Mayor received a domestic call last week from 911. None of our Police Officers answered the call. The Mayor will meet with them tomorrow evening.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.
