Regular Village Council Meeting
 December 8, 2008

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Jack Shouse, Wyndal Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Keith Staggs, Michele Watson, Betty Kirkpatrick and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. K. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. The Clerk Treasurer presented the Payment Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports to the Council, as well as the November, 2008 Bank Reconciliation. All reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mr. K. Staggs made a motion to continue to contract with Jared Cornett for street plowing at \$75.00 per hour. Mr. W. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to request an amended certificate from the Brown County Budget Commission for the General Fund in the amount of \$3,000.00, from Inheritance Tax. Mr. Shouse seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

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Mayor Talbott recognized Brett Gaspard from Rumpke, who came to present the CRI increase for 2009, which will raise our rates to \$15.75 per customer per month. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the new rate, and Mr. Shouse seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Talbott recognized Teresa Helton, who came to complain that North Avenue did not get salted or cleaned. The Council explained that none of the Village streets were cleared and apologized.

Gene Whisman complained to Mr. W. Staggs about his ditch. The Street Committee checked it and it seemed fine. Next spring the Street Committee will look at cleaning out some of the Village ditches.

Skip will move the speed limit signs on Wooster.

There will be a dinner for all employees and their families on January 18th.

Mr. W. Staggs made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. K. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
