

ORDINANCE NO. 265

ORDINANCE TO VACATE ERIE STREET FROM RICHEY STREET
SOUTH TO THE TERMINATION OF ERIE STREET

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of January, 1972, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Erie Street from Richey Street to termination of Erie Street was duly presented to Council praying that said street, between the points named, be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by posting in three public places within the Village for a period of six weeks ending February 1, 1972; and,

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE,
STATE OF OHIO:

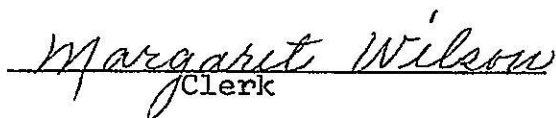
Section 1. That Erie Street from Richey Street to the south termination of Erie Street be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
