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**BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS
REGULAR MEETING
MONDAY JUNE 16, 1997 7:11 P.M.**

Timothy Sharp called the meeting to order at 7:11 P.M..

Mr. Sharp called for a motion to accept the minutes from the May 19, 1997 meeting.

Mr. Baker motioned to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Sharp seconded the minutes. All voted YEA. Opposed None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Sharp called for a motion to pay the bills as presented on the voucher. Mr. Baker motioned to pay the bills as presented. Mr. Sharp seconded the motion. All voted YEA. Opposed None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Sharp presented the board with a bid for gutters on the village Water and Electric Buildings

The bid was from Siemer Construction Co. of Hamersville in the amount of four hundred and twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$412.50). (This bid will become part of these minutes) It was decided to obtain another bid to be sure the board was getting the best price on the gutters. Mr. Sharp will obtain another bid before the July meeting.

Mr. Sharp questioned Mr. Van Harlingen on the installation of fire hydrants and Mr. Van Harlingen told the board that the only lines that cold have hydrants installed on them was six (6) inch lines.

The fire hydrants was tabled until more information could be obtained from the fire department.

Kay Elliott will call to see if Brown County has the water service on Drake Road near the trailer park.

Mr. Sharp motioned to purchase the paint (Thoro Seal) for the village buildings.

Mr. Baker seconded the motion. All voted YEA. Opposed None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Green will be in charge of getting the buildings painted using the Summer workers provided by JTPA. Mr. Green has two JTPA summer workers.

Mr. Dunn reported that he had received the transformers that he had ordered.

Ms. Elliott reported that she had One hundred and ten (110) on the shut off list.

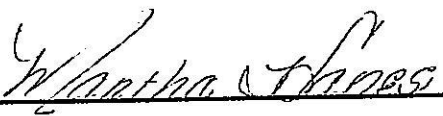
Mayor Neu questioned Mr. Van Harlingen as to why the water pressure was so much lower when the village is on Georgetown then when the Village is on Brown County Rural Water. Mr. Van Harlingen replied that the Brown County Water tower is higher the Hamersvilles and there fore the pressure is greater.

Mayor Neu reported that he has been trying to meet with Mr. Beasley on the White Oak Creek Project to see what FEMA is going pay on this project.

Mr. Van Harlingen said there was still some clean up work to be on this job.
