Regular Village Council Meeting
 June 13, 2011

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Harry Tolliver, Ragan Ernst, Keith Staggs, Wyndal Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the May, 2011 Bank Reconciliation. 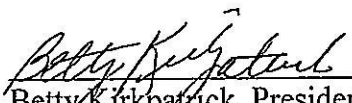
Chief Canter will deliver mowing notices.

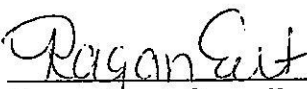
The headlights on the gray cruiser need fixed. The part is \$385.00.

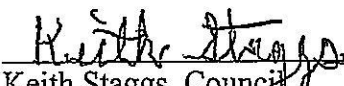
The Board and Council are planning to tour the Mt. Orab sewer plant on July 9.

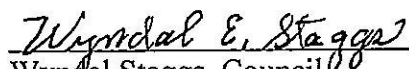
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. W Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

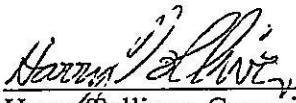
