

ORDINANCE NO. 246

ORDINANCE TO CREATE POSITION OF STREET COMMISSIONER - CHIEF OF POLICE OF VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, SET SALARY AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all members elected thereto, concurring as follows:

SECTION I. That the office of Street Commissioner - Chief of Police be created for the Village of Hamersville.

SECTION II. That the duties of the Street Commissioner - Chief of Police shall be responsibility for the maintenance of the streets and sidewalks, street signs, proper placement of street signs and acting in the capacity as Chief of Police of the Village, said office requiring sixty (60) hours per month excepting one month for vacation which shall require thirty (30) hours per month.

SECTION III. Salary for such office shall be One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) per year payable One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month in addition thereto Five Dollars (\$5.00) per month for uniform allowance. Such salary shall be divided Fifty Per Cent (50%) from the Street Fund and Fifty Per Cent (50%) from the General Fund.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, and a necessity and that this ordinance therefore shall be in immediate effect upon its passage.
