ORDINANCE NO: 2010-09

**ON ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE MOWING OF PROPERTY IN THE VILLAGE
OF HAMERSVILLE, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all members elected thereto concurring as follows:

Section 1: That the owners of lots, residences and other property in the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, shall be required to mow their property at least once every thirty (30) days during the months of April through October.

Section 2. That any person violating this ordinance shall be fined the sum of not more than \$25.00 for the first offense, not more than \$50.00 for the second offense and not more than \$100.00 for subsequent offenses.

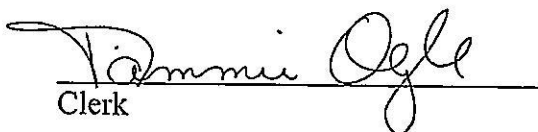
Section 3. For any person failing to mow a property for more than six weeks, the Village shall give notice of failure to mow by certified mail or hand delivery, and if the property is not mowed within 15 days of the receipt of the notice, the Village may cause said property to be mowed and certify the expense to the Auditor of Brown County, Ohio for collection as other taxes.
