

ORDINANCE NO. 1978-4

AN ORDINANCE VACATING BEECH ALLEY ON THE NORTH
SIDE OF MAIN STREET (KNOWN AS STATE ROUTE 125)
IN THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, BROWN COUNTY,
OHIO

SECTION 1.

WHEREAS, on the 27 day of JUNE, 1978, the Petition
by persons owning lots and land in the immediate vicinity of Beech
Alley, on the North side of Main Street (known as State Route 125)
in the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, was presented to Council
praying that said alley be vacated between the following points:
Beginning on the north side of Main Street, known as State Route
125, and continuing northeasterly for its full depth of 165 feet,
and being 15 feet in width, and

WHEREAS, notice of the pendency and prayer of the petition
was given by posting as required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is
good cause for such vacation as prayed for and that it will not be
detrimental to the general interest not to be made,

SECTION 2. NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of
the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, that Beech Alley
is vacated beginning on the north side of Main Street, known as
State Route 125, and continuing northeasterly for its full depth
of 165 feet, and being 15 feet in width.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance be and remain in full force
and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
