Village Council Meeting
 May 17, 2021

The Council of the Village of Hamersville met in regular session at the Village Municipal Building on Monday, May 17, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. with all members present except Joe Packer.

Also, present was: Guy Sutton, Shelley Spencer, Terrell Snider and David Grimes.

Mayor Hill called the meeting to order and led the everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Hill requested an executive session to discuss a personnel matter.

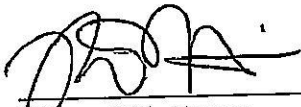

Motion by Ms. Miller, seconded by Mr. Wilson to return to regular session. Motion passed unanimously. Time Returned: 7:44 p.m.

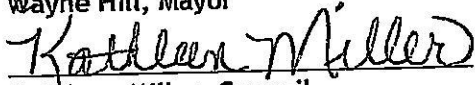
