Present: Mayor Steven Bowyer, Clerk Treasurer Martha Hanes, Council Members, Patrick Hanselman, James Johnston, Duane Neu, Wyndal Staggs.
 Also Present: Chief James Canter, from the Hamersville Police Department.

Mayor Bowyer called this special meeting to order for the purpose of passing an emergency Ordinance to purchase a new police cruiser. Mayor Bowyer read a statement from Kirby Cornett the owner of Cornetts Marathon stating that in his professional opinion the village need approximately Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) worth of repairs to the present cruiser.

Mr. Cornetts statement as read.

"TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN"

The Hamersville police cruiser needs some extensive work. The transmission needs to be rebuilt. The engine needs valve seals and most of the gaskets are leaking. To repair properly, the engine needs to be pulled. The front end needs shocks, ball joints, and tie rod ends. The steering rack leaks and needs to be replaced. Parts and labor could be as much as \$2000.00 (Two Thousand Dollars) If all this work is done. My professional opinion of this car is that it probably get by if used on a part time basis: but it should have all the above listed repairs if being used on a full time basis.

Mayor Bowyer said he had checked with the Village solicitor and that the village could pass an ordinance to replace the car as an emergency.

Mayor Bowyer presented Ordinance 1993-11 for the first reading. ORDINANCE 1993-11 An ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE CLERK TO PURCHASE A 1993 FORD CROWN VICTORIA POLICE INTERCEPTER FROM 32 FOR IN BATAVIA , OHIO FOR A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$12,500.00 (TWELVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED Dollars) and DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

Mayor Bowyer asked council what they wanted to do about passing this ordinance as an emergency since there was only four (4) Council members present and it requires five members (5) Members to pass emergency legislation.

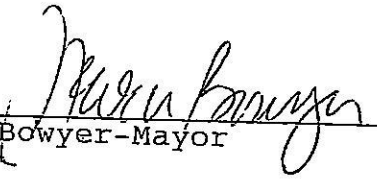
After much discussion a Decision was reached to instruct the Clerk to Post a notice to have another special meeting on Sunday April 18, 1993 at 7:00 P. M.
