

ORDINANCE NO. 1980-6

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS
TO THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE WATER STANDPIPE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all members elected thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION I: That WHEREAS the 200,000 gallon water storage standpipe for the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, is in need of immediate repair, both inside and outside, and WHEREAS, there are very few contractors available in this area who are properly trained and equipped to perform these services, NOW, THEREFORE,

SECTION II: BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, that the Trustees of the Board of Public Affairs of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, be and they hereby are authorized to make emergency repairs to both the inside and the outside of said tank costing in the approximate amount of Three Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$3,900.00).

SECTION III: That the Trustees of the Board of Public Affairs of Hamersville, Ohio, are authorized to make said emergency repairs without advertising for bids and there is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, the sum of Three Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$3,900.00) for the payment of the contract providing for the emergency repairs.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance in that it is necessary to make immediate emergency repairs to this 200,000 gallon standpipe for water storage owned by the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, both inside and outside, and it is necessary that said repairs be made while a qualified contractor is available in this area and said Ordinance is necessary for the public safety and health of

the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, and the inhabitants thereof and shall be in immediate effect upon its passage.
