from 6-7:30. Seconded by Steve Lowyer. Motion carried.

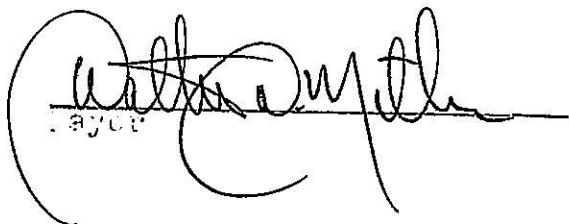

up new ordinance.

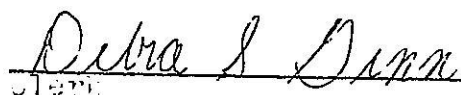
