The cost of the installation will be between two thousand dollars (\$2000) and two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2500.00)

The cost four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4500.00) if the school does the installation themselves.

The Board will visit Brown County Rural Water on March 24, 199 at 10 00 A.M.
Water markers are fifteen (\$15.00) to sixteen dollars (\$16.00) each if the Board
buys them from Brown County Rural Water.

Mr. Dunn reported that he had gotten safety equipment from Brenco in the amount
of one thousand and thirty five dollars. (\$1035.00)

Mt. Orab is coming to the collectors office on March 16, 1999 to check on the
sewer billing.

Mr. Baker motioned and Mr. Sharp seconded the motion to purchase a telephone
and fax machine for the utility collector not to exceed two hundred dollars
(\$200.00) All voted YEA. **MOTION CARRIED.**
