Board of Public Affairs
Regular Meeting
March 25, 1991 - 7:00 P.M.

Present: James Hanselman, Eric Mullis, Charles Tucker
Also present: Joyce Craig, Kay Elliott, Lynn Dunn

President Hanselman called the meeting to order and asked for the reading of the minutes of the previous meetings. Clerk-Treasurer Craig read the minutes of the meetings. They were approved as read.

Discussion was held on repair of brakes on electric department truck. Lynn told Board he had a bid of \$719.24 from Irvin Van Winkle, as cost for repair. Mullis moved, Tucker seconded the motion for Lynn to have Van Winkle repair brakes. All Voted Yea. Motion Carried.

Lynn informed Board that effective 1992 all operators of vehicles with gross weight of 26,000 lbs. or over needed a commercial driver's license. Lynn was fortunate to receive schooling on this at no cost to him, but it did cost \$28.00 to purchase CD License. Tucker moved, Mullis seconded the motion to reimburse Lynn Dunn for the license. All voted yea. Motion Carried.

Discussion was held on the 5% proposed increase for the Board of Public Affairs employees. Clerk-Treasurer informed Board that Council tabled the Ordinance for the increase due to lack of a motion. However, Solicitor Leicht advised Clerk-Treasurer that Board of Public Affairs could pass a resolution on the increases. But the resolution could not be retroactive. Mullis moved, Tucker seconded the motion to increase Lynn Dunn's hourly rate to \$19.99 per hour, Kay Elliott's hourly rate to \$4.73 per hour and Colby Saylor's hourly rate to \$7.35 per hour. Extra labor will remain at \$7.35. per hour, based upon additional information received from Solicitor. This increase will be effective with hours worked in April. All Voted Yea. Nay None Motion Carried.

President Hanselman informed the Board that a representative from the Company that did repair work on our water tower a few years ago may attend our next regular meeting.

It was consensus of opinion that deliveries for water and electric department would be made to Village of Property.

There being no further business, Mullis moved to adjourn the meeting, Tucker seconded the motion. All voted yea. Motion Carried.

President Hanselman adjourned the meeting. Next regular meeting will be April 22, 1991 at 7:00 P.M.
