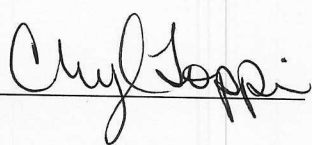
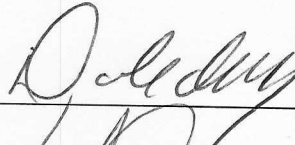
Meeting was called to order at 7:05PM with the pledge of allegiance.

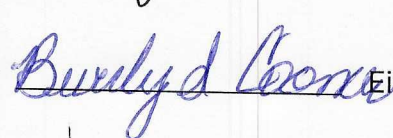
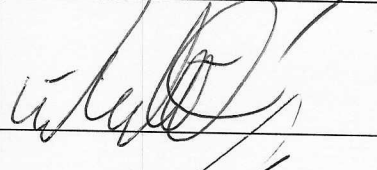

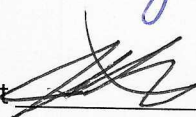
