April 8, 2002

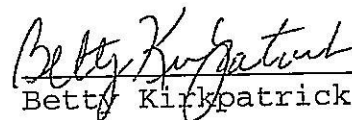

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Shuemade seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.

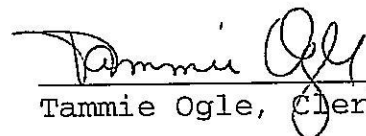
