Chief Canter gave his report.

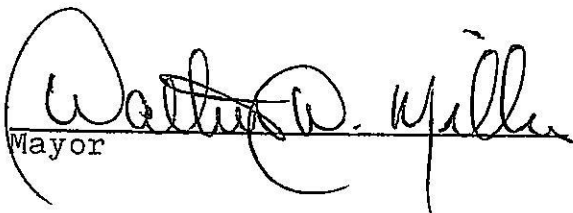
The Finance commintte will meet Sunday May 22 at 2:00 p.m.
