

Village of Hamersville
Board of Public Affairs - Regular Meeting
Community Building
March 27, 1990 - 7:00 P.M.

The Hamersville Board of Public Affairs met in regular session.

Present were: James Hanselman, Eric Mullis, Charles Tucker.

Also present were: Joyce Craig, Lynn Dunn, Kay Elliott, and Colby Saylor.

President Hanselman called the meeting to order and asked Clerk-Treasurer to read the minutes of the previous meeting.

The minutes were read and were approved as read.

The bills were read and approved for payment.

Clerk-Treasurer informed Board the Ordinance for increase of salaries for Board of Public Affair employees would be ready for Council's adoption at regular meeting April 2nd, 1990. It would be retroactive to February 1, 1990. Collector Kay Elliott questioned if anything was decided whether or not she was entitled to sick leave pay.

Correspondence was read from Solicitor Leicht pertaining to salary increases. Board agreed to have Mr. Leicht attend our next regular Board meeting, April 23, 1990, to answer our questions.

President Hanselman asked Mr. Lynn Dunn and Mr. Colby Saylor if they had anything they would like to bring to the Board's attention. Mr. Dunn said he was concerned about the moving of the electric box which controlled the pump on the Village gas tank. Also, trimming of trees in the village, Mr. Dunn said not to hire an outside contractor, he would do the trimming of trees. Also he would install street lights at Farrell's Dairy Bar, Antonio's pizza place and the auction place.

Discussion was held on removal of electric poles which are currently on the new park property. Moving the poles will be quite involved plus concrete holders should be prepared so poles do not lay directly on ground.

Board will discuss with the Council the plans for the new park and question whether or not installation for water lines are a part of the park grant.

There being no further business, Tucker moved to adjourn, Mullis seconded. President Hanselman adjourned the meeting.
