Regular Village Council Meeting
April 9, 2001

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle, and the following members of the Village Council: Donnie Sowers, Bill Dean, Kevin Ogle, Joyce Craig, and Wyndal Staggs.
Also Present: Kay Elliott, Kenny Green, Police Chief Jim Canter, Cecelia Potts and Scott Lanter.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., then led the assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the financial reports, which included the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue and Expenditure Status, and the minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Dean seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Ms. Craig made motion to pay all bills as presented, and Mr. Dean seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Ronnie Blair has taken care of the culvert on Mill Street. Mr. Dean asked if we can pile up the limbs that are down in town and burn them-maybe see if we can get the Fire Department to control it. Mr. Ogle informed him that the State of Ohio has a "no burn" policy right now. Clark Township is getting ready to burn some trash on Sodom Road, maybe we could take it there.

April 9, 2001, cont'd.

Ms. Potts will check the Law Library to find a copy of our Trash Ordinances. We need to update and enforce them. Mr. Sowers suggested having Rumpke bring a truck specifically for yard waste, or we could talk to Georgetown, they have a place where they dump stuff all the time. The Council members discussed having a clean-up day just for the Village. The trucks would cost more than we have appropriated in our Trash fund. Mr. Dean suggested adding \$.50 or \$1.00 per week to everyone's garbage bill. Would we be able to afford it then? Chief Canter objected to this idea, and it was tabled. Mr. Staggs told Chief Canter to get a list of offenders of the trash ordinance by the next Council meeting. Mr. Staggs, Mayor Neu and Chief Canter will go around town together to make up a list, and the Clerk Treasurer will draft a letter for the offenders.

ODOT has set up a date for the work on 774. We need to move our sewer line at Neal's Corner. Brandstetter and Carroll is supposed to have done the engineering already. The microswitches on the pumps are going bad. We need to go back to the manufacturer.

Mayor Neu received a letter from Al Rhonemus proclaiming May 3 the National Day of Prayer. Mr. Dean made a motion to make it so in Hamersville, and Mr. Sowers seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Dean suggested that the Clerk Treasurer call Doug Green (Brown County Auditor) and ask him what our revenue would be if we ran a new Levy for the Police, 1 1/2 mil. The Clerk Treasurer will have this information at our next meeting. Mr. Ogle asked if we are going to pave the streets this year. Wooster, Sistersville, and North all need work. The Street Committee will meet on 4-12 at 5:00.

Ordinance 2001-06 was read for the second time. Mr. Dean made a motion to adopt this Ordinance for Adelphia. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

The insurance renewal from PEP came in. Mr. Ogle made a motion to renew at 1 million. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Dean made a motion to get a Dodge Dakota from Arena Dodge in Dayton for \$12,895.00 This is to be taken from all four funds. Mr. Ogle seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

ABCAP is weatherizing low income homes in the county. There was one done here in Hamersville last week.

Mr. Ogle made the motion to adjourn, and Mr. Dean seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.
