ORDINANCE NO. 1991-8

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF WAYNE AVENUE

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, three-fourths or more of all members thereof concurring as follows, that:

SECTION I. A petition was filed with the Council requesting that the Council vacate that portion of Wayne Avenue situated west of the west boundary of Adkins Place as extended across Wayne Avenue by owners of the lands abutting said portion of Wayne Avenue to be vacated. That notice of said petition is not necessary inasmuch as the petition was signed by the owners of all the land abutting said portion of Wayne Avenue to be vacated.

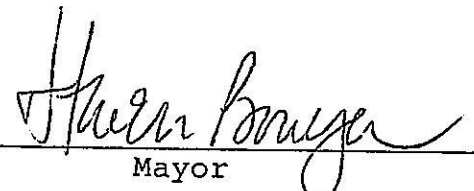
SECTION II. That there appears to be good cause for the vacation and there will be no detriment to the general interest of the public in vacating that portion of Wayne Avenue.

SECTION III. That the petition be approved and the Village vacate that portion of Wayne Avenue west of the west boundary of Adkins Place as extended across Wayne Avenue.

SECTION IV. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville and more particularly to insure the safety of the pedestrians in the Village of Hamersville and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
