Declaring an Emergency.

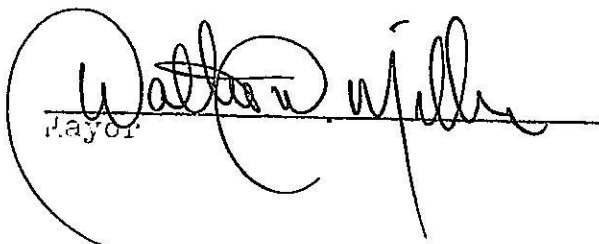
Motion by Powyer to suspend the rules and read Ordinance #
1988-8 by title only. Seconded by Hanes. Motion carried.

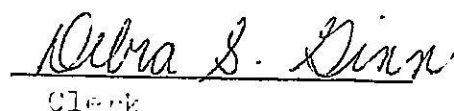
Motion by Stephens to suspend the rules and read Ordinance #
