Regular Village Council Meeting
 June 9, 2008

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

In reference to the previous month's meeting, the \$20.00 fee does not apply if the MARCS radio is used only for emergencies.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the May, 2008 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to approve the following job description for the Street Maintenance employee:

The Hamersville Street maintenance employee shall;

Maintain the Streets and sidewalks of the Village, and all aspects of the Streets. The normal approved hours for the Street Maintenance employee is seven (7) per week. Any hours over are to be specifically approved, in advance, by the Mayor. The Street maintenance employee shall mow all lots owned by the Village as needed, as well as mowing any lots or residences when directed by the Mayor due to the owners neglect. The employee shall keep all street

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signs in good condition, and replace them when necessary. The employee shall also put up and remove the American Flags for Holidays.

The Village vehicle is to be used for Village business only. All maintenance on Village vehicles is to be done by a licensed mechanic.

Mr. Shouse seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. W. Staggs made a motion for a Supplemental Appropriation of \$500.00 to Transfer-Out. Mr. Tolliver seconded it, and the motion carried, all voting yes. Mr. K. Staggs made a motion to transfer \$500.00 from the General Fund to Police Protection. Mr. Shouse seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Talbott thanked the Council Members and Chief Canter for the service they have provided to the Village.
