Regular Village Council Meeting
 July 9, 2012

Present: Mayor Keith Staggs, Ragan Ernst, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Harry Tolliver, Pat Scott, John Kirby and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Also present: Chief Canter, Suzanne Madden, Donna Tolliver and David Grimes.

Mayor Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status Reports, and the June, 2012 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Ms. Scott seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills, and Mr. Kirby seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

We have installed the culverts as discussed in previous meetings. The Council discussed the flooding on Fite Avenue. Brown County Lawn & Garden has blocked the ditch in front of their business.

Mayor Staggs and Chief Canter got an estimate for the carpet at the Mayor's Court from Village Carpet for \$926.00. Mayor Staggs will get another one from Bill Sherman.

The Board of Public Affairs recommended signing a two year extension to our current electric contract, citing the election as a factor in pricing. Ms. Scott remarked that she is worried about signing two years in advance. She wants to wait until the election. The

Council discussed the issue. Ms. Tolliver told Council that she thinks it is a good deal. Bethel and Ripley have administrators who think it is a good deal. The ancillary charges will jump from \$2.00 to \$10.00. Mr. Kirby made a motion to table the discussion until the next meeting, giving Council an opportunity to read over the proposed contract. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes, except Mr. Tolliver, who voted no.

Ms. Tolliver asked for a committee to meet with companies when contracts are in discussion.

The Council discussed the upcoming Flag Ceremony, which will be July 14 at 1:00 p.m.

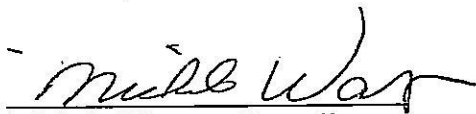
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Ernst seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

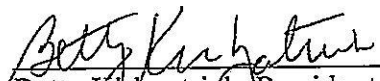

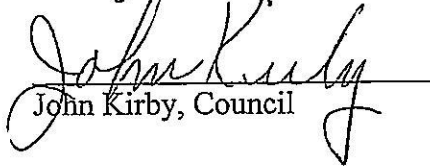

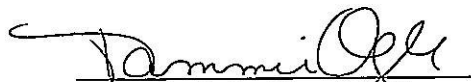
