

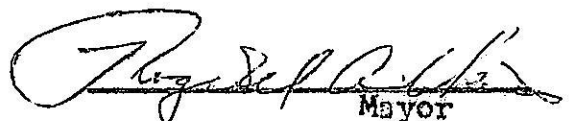
RESOLUTION OBLIGATING THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO TO
PAY ALL PROJECT COSTS OF VILLAGE WATERWORKS SYSTEM
EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED AND THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4ths) or more of all members elected thereto concurring, as follows:

Section I. That Whereas, the Village of Hamersville, Ohio is in the process of a project constructing a waterworks distribution system in the Village of Hamersville and surrounding territory in Brown County, Ohio, and whereas, the Village of Hamersville has applied for and received a Federal Grant from the Housing and Home Finance Agency in Chicago for part of the total cost of said project.

Section II. Now Therefore, be it resolved by the Incorporated Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, that this Village be and it hereby is obligated to pay all project costs and expenses, including all construction bills and costs and all other bills and costs in connection with said project, that exceed the sum of Two Hundred Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$239,000.00), from its own funds, and that this Village shall be liable for any and all project costs or expenses that exceed the sum of Two Hundred Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$239,000.00).

Section III. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency resolution necessary for the public health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, in order to complete the Waterworks Distribution Project in order to supply an adequate and safe supply of drinking water and water for fire protection and shall be in effect immediately upon its passage.
