

RESOLUTION NO. 70

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE AWARD OF CONTRACT
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER WORKS SYSTEM FOR THE
VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO.

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Hamersville,
Brown County, Ohio,

That Whereas the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio,
has heretofore determined to undertake the financing and construction
of a municipal water works for the public health and welfare and,

Whereas the Village has advertised for bids on the work
including all labor and material for the complete installation of
said water works ready for full operation in accordance with the
plans and specifications as prepared by the Village Engineer and,

Whereas the Village did advertise for bids in the News
Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation in Brown County, Ohio,
for three (3) consecutive weeks, the first advertisement being
published May 9th, 1963, and a similar advertisement published on
May 16th and May 23rd, 1963, and,

Whereas the said bids were publicly opened and read on May 24th,
1963, at Twelve O'clock noon by said village officials and,

Whereas J. S. Kennoy, D.B.A. Kennoy & Company, Consulting
Engineers, Lexington, Kentucky, has made a recommendation that
Division I of said project be awarded to the Globe Industrial
Contractors of Henderson, Kentucky, and,

Whereas said Village Engineer has also recommended that
Division II of said project be awarded to Glenn Rhoades, D.B.A.
Glenn Rhoades Construction Company, Mt. Orab, Ohio, and,

Whereas the Village Solicitor, Philip K. McConn, attorney of
Georgetown, Ohio, has expressed the opinion that the award to the
two contractors hereinbefore referred to will constitute a legal
award,

Now Therefore, be it resolved by the Council of the Village
of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. That the award of the contract for the items of
work and construction called for in said water works

project be awarded as follows: Division I - Globe Industrial Contractors of Henderson, Kentucky in the amount of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$14,565.00), Division II - Glenn Rhoades, D.B.A. Glenn Rhoades Construction Company, Mt. Orab, Ohio, in the amount of One Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty Dollars and Fifty-eight Cents (\$193,960.58).

Section 2. That whereas said project is to be completed under the terms of the grant offer received and accepted by the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, from the Housing & Home Finance Agency, Community Facilities Administration under the Accelerated Public Works Program, being Project No. APW-OHIO-26G and being Contract No. H-402-856.

Now Therefore be it further resolved that said award be contingent on the concurrence in this award by the Housing & Home Financing Agency, Community Facilities Administration.

That this award of bid be subject to the contractors hereinbefore referred to entering a contract with this Village all in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the Clerk of this Village for the proposed construction of the Village Water Works System.

Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency resolution necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Hamersville, Ohio, and more particularly for the construction of a municipal water works system for the furnishing of a safe supply of drinking water and for the furnishing of fire protection and that this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
