Regular Village Council Meeting
September 12, 2016

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, Kim Budke, Kathleen Miller, Wayne Hill, Dale Owsley and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Jack Jones, Jason LaRue, Louie Luttrell, Chief Sutton, Matt Ernst, Mary Collins and Solicitor David Grimes.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the August, 2016 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Budke made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. Hill seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Kirkpatrick introduced Mary Collins, whom she has appointed to Council. She then swore her in.

Mr. Ernst asked Council to do something about the factory on Fite Avenue storing junk cars. Chief Sutton will talk to them.

Beggar's Night will be October 31, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The Fiscal Officer will talk to the Fire Chief.

Ms. Miller made a motion to give Melissa and Jack \$.50 per hour raises, retroactive to September 1, per the BPA. Mr. Hill seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Budke made a motion to give Jack up to 60 hours per month to do Street work, sidewalk cleanup/repair and mowing. Mr. Hill seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Chief Sutton informed Council that when the utilities are paid for the property on Wayne Avenue, it will be dangerous for our employees to enter the property. Mr. Grimes will prepare an Ordinance for their safety.

Mr. Hill complained about the speed of the volunteer firefighters driving through town. Chief Sutton will talk to the Fire Chief.

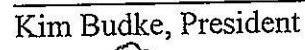
Ms. Miller made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Budke seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

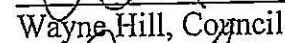

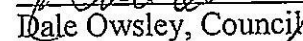
