Regular Village Council Meeting
 August 10, 2015

Mayor Kirkpatrick brought this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ms. Miller seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Watson made a motion to make the following appropriation changes:

Decrease 5201-541-690 Other \$15,786.25

Increase 5201-910-910 Transfer Out \$15,786.25

Increase 3401-850-710 Interest \$29,825.01

Ms. Miller seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

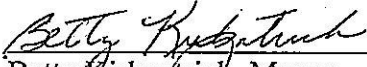
Mr. Jones asked if we can install a street light at the park. The Mayor will talk to the Board about putting one there and one at the Police Building.

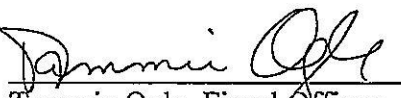
Ms. Watson and Ms. Budke brought up hosting either a spring or summer festival.

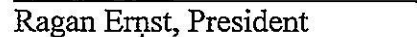
Mr. Jones made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Budke seconded it.

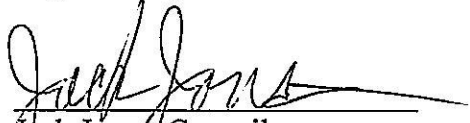

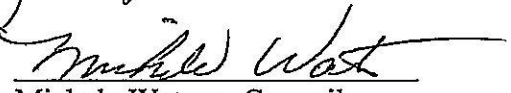
