Regular Village Council Meeting
 August 8, 2016

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, Kathleen Miller, Kim Budke, Dale Owsley, Wayne Hill and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Also present: Chief Sutton, Jason LaRue, Jack Jones, David Grimes, Mary Collins, Bobbie Thomas, Bill Godby, Mike Starkey, Troy Braunstein, Chris and Amy Riggs, Chuck Crawford and Brandon Copley.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Fund Status, Revenue Status, and Appropriation Status reports, and the July 31, 2016 Bank reconciliation. Ms. Miller made a motion to accept the minutes, and Ms. Budke seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Kirkpatrick recognized Pastors Godby, Starkey and Braunstein, who came to discuss the how the Churches in Hamersville work together to make an impact on the Community.

Mr. Owsley asked about the policies in place during emergencies. He brought pool shock treatment to show that it can be used to make pond water potable, and a small jet or rocket stove (which he builds) that burns small pieces of wood. Chief Sutton explained our policies.

Mayor Kirkpatrick recognized Bobbie Thomas, who asked about the storm siren. Mayor Kirkpatrick told her that we had called for repairs.

Mayor Kirkpatrick recognized Mary Collins, who came to complain about her neighbors on Wayne Avenue. They have no electricity or plumbing, are sleeping and making messes outside. Chief Sutton told her they have been cited to court. We will write a letter to be signed by the Mayor and all Council members to the Brown County Health Department.

Chief Sutton asked to purchase a generator for \$500.00. Mr. Hill made a motion to purchase it, and Ms. Budke seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

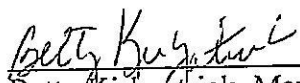

Ms. Miller made a motion to pay all bills as presented, and Mr. Hill seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

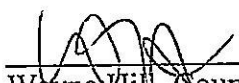

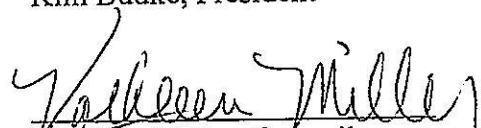

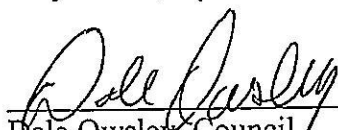
Ms. Budke made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Miller seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

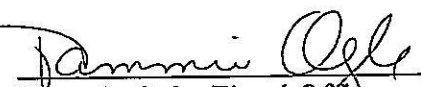
