AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 237 AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown
County, Ohio, at least a majority of its members concurring:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 237, adopted by Village Council in 1968
and prohibiting mailboxes on village streets and alleys is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure for the reason that it directly affects the health safety and welfare of the
residents of the Village of Hamersville.
