Resolution # 1988-6 was introduced : Declaring the amount  
of taxes that may be raised by levy at the maximum rate  
authorized by law without a vote of the electors to be  
insufficient and declaring the necessity of a renewal levy  
in excess of such rate.

Motion by Hanselman to put resolution as an operating  
levy on the ballot at the November elections. Seconded by  
Walker, Motion carried.

Chief Canter introduced Mr. Glenn Furnside to council.

Motion to hire Mr. Glenn Furnside as a probationary officer  
by Hanselman seconded by Bowyer. Motion carried.

Ordinance # 1988-7 Introduced. An ordinance to require  
mowing of property in the Village of Hamersville, Brown  
County, Ohio and to declare an emergency.

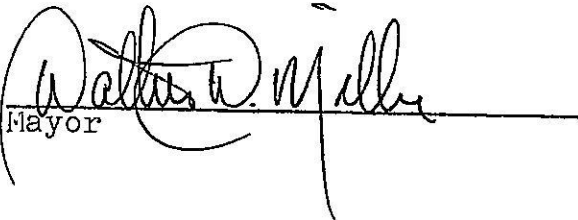
Motion by Bowyer seconded by Moore to suspend the rules and
