

ORDINANCE NO. 1983-6

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF LOT NO. 10
IN THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE NOT
NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville,
Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members
thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION I. That the following described real estate belonging
to the Village of Hamersville is not needed for any municipal
purpose, to wit:

Situated in the Village of Hamersville,
Township of Clark, County of Brown and in the
State of Ohio and being all of Lot No. Ten (10)
in the Incorporated Village of Hamersville, as
the same is known and designated on the recorded
plat of said Village.

This being the same real estate conveyed by
deed from Gene Cravens, et al to the Incorporated
Village of Hamersville by deed dated September 21,
1982, recorded September 22, 1982 in Volume 202,
Page 658, Deed Records of Brown County, Ohio.

SECTION II. That the Mayor of this Village be and hereby
is authorized to sell said real estate to the highest bidder
according to law, upon the following terms: cash; and the said
Mayor and the Clerk of this village are hereby authorized to
convey said real estate by deed to the highest bidder therefore
according to law.

SECTION III. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and
welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Brown
County, Ohio and more particularly for the reason that the
Village needs the revenue to be received from the sale of this
property for municipal purposes and this ordinance shall be in
full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
