

ORDINANCE NO. 1992-9

ADOPTING THE 1992 S-14 SUPPLEMENT TO THE
REVISED OHIO BASIC CODE FOR THE
VILLAGE OF Hامنsville AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has completed an updating of the Revised Ohio Basic Code for the Village of Hامنsville, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of Council to accept such supplements to its codified ordinances, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipal departments, and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety that this ordinance take effect at an early date: now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF Hامنsville
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the 1992 S-14 Supplement to the Revised Ohio Basic Code for the Village of Hامنsville, as reviewed and approved by Council, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. One copy of the Revised Ohio Basic Code for the Village of Hامنsville together with the 1992 S-14 Supplement, shall be kept on file in the office of the Clerk of the Village. The Clerk is authorized and directed to publish a summary of all new matters contained in the 1992 S-14 Supplement to the Revised Ohio Basic Code for the Village of Hامنsville as required by R.C. § 731.23.

Section 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of Hامنsville so as to conform Village ordinances to recent changes in state law, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that on the August 3, 1992 there was enacted by the Council of the Village of Hامنsville an ordinance entitled "ADOPTING THE 1992 S-14 SUPPLEMENT TO THE REVISED OHIO BASIC CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF Hامنsville AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

A summary of the subjects, including all new matters contained in the 1992 S-14 Supplement as adopted, follows:

TITLE III: ADMINISTRATION

Chapter 36. Civil Actions Against the Municipality. This chapter contains provisions from state law which deal with lawsuits against the village government.

TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE

Chapter 70. General Provisions. This chapter contains provisions applicable to the entire title.

Chapter 72. Traffic Rules. This chapter contains provisions from state law governing the operation of vehicles.

Chapter 73. Motor Vehicle Crimes. This chapter contains provisions from state law prohibiting certain conduct to regard to vehicles.

Chapter 76. Parking Regulations. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating parking.

TITLE IX: GENERAL REGULATIONS

Chapter 92. Intoxicating Liquors. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating sale and consumption of intoxicating liquor.

TITLE XIII: GENERAL OFFENSES

Chapter 130. General Provisions. This chapter contains definitions and provisions generally applicable throughout the title.

Chapter 132. Offenses Against Public Peace. This chapter contains prohibitions involving certain acts which interfere with the public peace.

Chapter 136. Offenses Against Justice and Administration. This chapter contains provisions prohibiting certain acts which interfere with justice and administration.

Chapter 138. Drug Offenses. This chapter contains provisions regulating the use, sale, and possession of specified drugs.
