September 11, 2006

Present: Mayor Wyndal Stagge, Larry Talbott, Harry Tolliver, Keith Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Jack Shouse and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Skip Bollinger, Donna Tolliver, Ed Saylor, Jim & Mary Hanselman, Jim Canter and Cecelia Potts.

Mayor Staggs called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for the victims of 9-11.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status Reports, and the August 2006 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved by the Council.

Mayor Staggs recognized Jim Hanselman, who came to complain that the vacant house they own in town has been vandalized. Chief Canter will go take a report on it. They also complained about Council signing off on their neighbor's re-plat, which they claim takes over part of their property. Ms. Potts explained to them that Council's signature only shows that we know it was done. They thanked Council for their time.

Mayor Staggs then recognized Ed Saylor, who came because Chief Canter stopped at his property on Main Street about the horses he keeps there. Council gave him a copy of Ordinance #2005-06, which restricts animals within the Village. He explained that these are the same horses he has had there since January, 2005. Mayor Staggs told him that there would be no further problem, and he thanked Council for their time.
