Regular Village Council Meeting
September 8, 2003

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Larry Talbott, Kevin Ogle, Harry Tolliver and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.
Also Present: Eric Johnson, Cecelia Potts, Bruce Brandstetter, Police Chief Jim Canter, Kenny Green and Tim Perry.

Mr. Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Talbott made a motion to appoint Mr. Johnson to the Council. Mr. Ogle seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes. Ms. Potts then swore Mr. Johnson in, and he took a seat at the table.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous month's meeting, and Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs recognized Bruce Brandstetter, who came to discuss the meeting he had with the Street Committee about an Issue II grant for new sidewalks. It is not really geared for sidewalks, so he will apply for the grant as a drainage issue. This would be to replace the curbs, sidewalks and catch basins. He recommended a 20% match from the Village. The Council agreed to go for a grant of \$520,000 with a 10% match. The sidewalks are 46 years old. Mr. Talbott made a motion to suspend the rules for reading a Resolution three times, and Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Ogle made a motion to adopt Resolution 2003-10, authorizing the Mayor to represent the Village in the grant. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

We still need flags. We put up the old ones for Labor Day after getting complaints about them not being up. We will leave them until after Patriot Day. The Council decided to table the discussion until next year.

We are having some flooding problems on Fite Avenue. We put in a 12" culvert at Bibbs', but it isn't big enough. Ms. Kirkpatrick suggested having Ronnie Blair look at the problem. Mr. Staggs will talk to him, and Mr. Talbott and Mr. Tolliver will work with Eric to try to resolve the problems on Wooster.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an Ordinance three times. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2003-11 regulating the storage of automobiles and automobile parts in the Village. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, with all members voting yes.

The Council agreed to purchase a smaller weedeater for Jared and a grease gun for the Street Department.

Beggar's Night was set for October 30 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., to coincide with the other towns in this area.

Mr. Staggs has had some complaints about the east end of Wooster being too narrow. Mr. Talbott made a motion to make it a one way street going out of town from the round house down. Mr. Ogle suggested putting in ditches and berms. He will check into the right of way.

Council instructed the Clerk Treasurer to advertise for bids for snow

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removal, to be opened at our next meeting.

Brown County Asphalt gave us a quote for striping and painting curbs, crosswalks, etc. of \$3568.80. We will let it go until next year, and have Chuck and Jared paint the crosswalks.

The Council appointed Ms. Potts, Mr. Staggs and Mr. Tolliver to the Records Committee.

Chief Canter informed the Council that the vests are all in. They are having a problem with line of sight at Travis and St. Rt. 125.

Mr. Staggs read a letter of resignation from Suzanne Madden, the Mayor's Court Clerk, effective October 31. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept it, and Mr. Ogle seconded it. The motion carried, all members voting yes. We will advertise for a replacement.

Ms. Kirkpatrick suggested giving the Police Department 25 more hours per month. Mr. Ogle made a motion to do so, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Cecelia is still working on the blue house. She will send us a copy of Mt. Orab's solution.

The Council agreed to fix the holes in the Post Office parking lot.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded. The motion carried, all voting yes.
