

WHEREAS, on the 3 day of July, 1972, Ordinance No. 268, was adopted by the Village of Hamersville authorizing the sale of certain land and buildings being part of Lot 19, in the Village of Hamersville at public sale, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said ordinance two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring advertisement was ran in the News Democrat, newspaper of general circulation in the Village for five (5) consecutive weeks, advertising said public auction, and

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of June, 1972, auction took place in conjunction with the Township Trustees of Clark Township, Brown County, Ohio, owners of the other portion of the premises described, and

WHEREAS, the bidder entering the highest bid, for both the property of the Village of Hamersville, and the Trustees of Clark Township was the Citizens Bank of Hamersville, in the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the bid of the Citizens Bank be approved and that the sale of the property be approved, and that the Mayor and the President of the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs be and hereby are authorized and directed to execute a general warranty deed for said property to the said successful bidder, Citizens Bank of Hamersville, upon the receipt of the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) payable to the Village of Hamersville and Clark Township Trustees.
